



Placard Instructions

PASMUN 2022

Although PASMUN 2022 will be carried out online, the traditional procedure with regards to placards will stay the same. For this reason, we have provided a detailed outline on how to make a placard for your respective delegation.

1. Make a copy of this document
2. Download the attached example placard to your drive or computer.
3. Once you have done this, in the space indicated as demonstrated in the example below, write the name of your delegation as large as possible.
4. In a similar manner, look up your delegation's flag and paste it in the indicated area as seen in the example. If you represent an individual, you are not required to include an image.
5. Once you have both your delegation's name and flag, print the document out (it is not necessary for the placard to be in color).
6. After you have completed the previous instructions, fold the document along the indicated lines as to create a triangle when viewed from the side.
7. Use tape or glue to ensure that your placard remains in the indicated form for the entirety of the event.
8. Now that you have your placard, you are ready to participate in PASMUN 2022.

*If you do not have a printer at home and are unable to print your placard elsewhere, you must replicate the format of the placard on a sheet of paper, writing your delegation's name as large as possible (make sure that your writing is legible).
