

The Munich Conference

September 29-30, 1938



**It is 1938 and the world is at the
brink of war. Adolf Hitler has
plotted an advance over Czcho-
slovakia, and France and Brit-
ain are concerned this advance
may escalate into a full scale
war. This is an opportunity to
rewrite history.**

At the beginning of the first session, the representatives of each delegation will have an opportunity to join together. One representative of each nation must deliver that delegation's initial position.

All delegates must write a position paper, in first person, representing their nation's interests. It may be written as a speech, of up to 10 minutes.
